<p>Imagination Train (ages 2 to 6 years): This drama-based program will have children using their imagination to board a train and travel to unique destinations where they will experience an adventure like no other. A small art project is included. Themes include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Safari Adventure - Under The Sea - Outer Space - Alphabet Adventure (with Chicka-Chicka-Boom Boom) - Western - Seasonal Adventures (holiday and weather related adventures) 	<p>Drama Program (ages 6 plus): Children explore and learn about drama through various activities which promote group work, cooperation, and self-expression. This workshop will take the children through voice, movement and imagination exercises and at the end children will have a chance to act out little skits. Additional topics including tableau and mime available. Multiple sessions available upon request.</p>
<p>Art of Science (ages 3 to 6 years): Children explore the wonderful world of science through hands-on experiments, from colours and rainbows to how a plant grows. Other themes include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Volcanoes - Tornadoes - Magnets - Solids, Liquids, and Gases - Flight - Slime and other gross things - Senses 	<p>Creative Experiments (ages 6 to 8 years): Children put science to the test and discover how things work with hands-on experiments and craft projects. Themes include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Structures - Levers - Music/Sound - Magnets - Volcanoes

<p>Storytime Studio (ages 5 to 8) Children will create a personal hardcover story “All About Me” using a variety of mixed media. A variety of templates are available or there can be an opportunity more free expression. The end result a memory to last a lifetime.</p> <p>This workshop is great for school wide events to promote literacy for all ages. Cost per child can be as low as \$6.50. Children will be guided them through imagining, planning and creating their own story complete with illustrations. This workshop can be centred on a specific theme or the opportunity for free expression! A great classroom project to expand on once we leave.</p>
<p>Van Gough’s Canvas (ages 2 to 6 years): Children explore and learn about the world of colour and paint by creating masterpieces using a variety of paint techniques and materials.</p>	<p>Canvas Creations (ages 7 to 12 years): Children become junior artists creating masterpieces on canvas while learning a variety of paint techniques.</p>
<p>Watercolour Program (ages 7 to 12 years): This class will introduce children to basic knowledge and the unique materials of painting with watercolours. They will learn three basic painting techniques that they can learn to master when they will finish the class off by painting a still life portrait! This can be a two part series with the second class the children learning three effects .</p>	<p>Acrylic Painting (ages 7 to 12 years): Children explore their artistic side by painting craft pieces with acrylics. Available craft projects include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Wooden boxes - Piggy Banks - Wooden Plaques
<p>Clay Creations (ages 4 to 12 years): This program offers children the chance to put their imaginations to work and design a clay creation which air dries and can be painted and decorated. Great project for JK and SK, a dinoland complete with working volcano, fossil and watering hole.</p>	<p>Plaster Masks (ages 7 to 12 years): Children design a mask and use moulds and plaster to bring their design to life. Paint and decorations are added to make this craft project extra special.</p>
<p>Junior Designers (ages 4 to 12 years): Children can try out their talents as an interior decorator, fashion designer and jewellery designer. This will help children take pride in their creativity and allow them to discover the benefits of creating unique keepsakes that can be worn or used to decorate their room. From bulletin boards to personalized signs to t-shirts and bracelets and more.</p>	<p>Other Art Projects: Plaster of Paris hand prints, Tie Dying T-shirts, Fabric Painting, Sand Art, Designing Picture Frames, and more added all the time. Make Garden Stones.</p>
